Benthic Macroinvertebrate Assessment Training

TU and WV Rivers are partnering with the WVDEP Save our Streams Program to train our volunteers to conduct benthic macroinvertebrate assessments at their monitoring sites.

Collecting, identifying and counting aquatic insects is a great way to gauge the long-term and cumulative health of a stream, and serves as a useful companion to our water quality data.

We hope to conduct benthic assessments at as many of our monitoring sites as possible to build a strong record of baseline conditions.

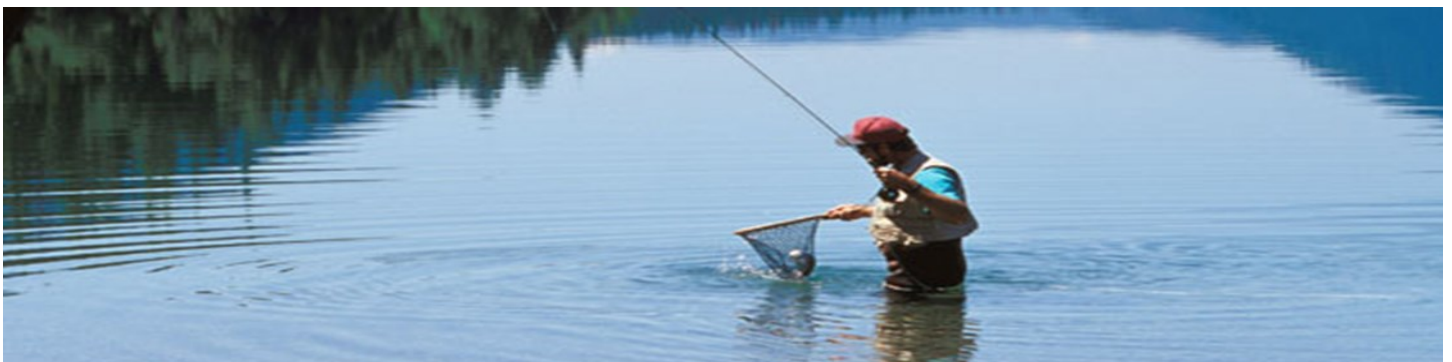
