PFAS exceeding health advisories found in the raw water supply for 130 community water systems in West Virginia

Based on results from a recent study¹ commissioned by DHHR and DEP, unsafe levels of PFAS were found in the raw water supply for 130 community water systems, impacting in total over 700,000 West Virginians.

The tables attached identify these systems in alphabetical order and by House or Senate district.

For all of these systems, PFOA and/or PFOS levels in raw water exceeded their respective health advisories, which currently are 0.004 ppt for PFOA and 0.02 ppt for PFOS.

These health advisory levels, which were updated in June 2022, are based on new science and consider lifetime exposure. They indicate that negative health effects may occur with concentrations of PFOA or PFOS in water that are near zero.

Notes

Community Water System. The community water system name is a simplified name that omits “Public Service District” or “Utility Board” or other similar items.

PFOA + PFOS (ppt). This is the total concentration of these two PFAS measured in parts per trillion. For reference, EPA’s health advisories are 0.004 ppt for PFOA and 0.02 ppt for PFOS.

Areas Served. The areas served are as reported by community water systems required to file annual reports with the West Virginia Public Service Commission (PSC). Different systems report their areas served differently. For systems that do not file reports with the PSC, additional research was performed to determine the areas served.

Population Served. Population served is from the Bureau for Public Health Drinking Water Watch database at <https://dww.wvdhhr.org/DWWpublic/>.

Senate District. Senate districts are based on the reported areas served, as well as additional research. Systems were assigned into a single Senate district, although some systems may serve customers in more than one district.

House District. House districts are based on the reported areas served, as well as additional research. Many systems serve customers in more than one House district. Despite best efforts to identify all House districts served by each system, the list of systems for each House district is likely to be incomplete.
